2) For the 2008/2009 Soccer Season, the Ladner Soccer Club is going to be very aggressive in getting returning players' re-registration forms handed in prior to the end of the of the 2007/2008 season. Make sure this form is returned to your coach within two weeks of receiving it. Placement on teams is based on trying to make/keep all teams competitive, as well as making all effort to keep returning teams together.

**Returning players who hand in forms later than funday will forfeit any preferences they may have.**

### REFUNDS AND FEES

There will no refunds after the 2nd week of league play. Any registered player dropping out after 15th August will be charged a \$20 administration fee. **Please notify the registrar to receive a refund.**

### COMMENCEMENT OF GAMES

The 2008 /2009 soccer season commences with the first games for the U11's to U18's, on the weekend after the Labour day weekend. This is a very busy time for the Ladner Soccer Club Coaches, Volunteers and Executive, with boys returning to school and the club still contacting coaches who have been away on holiday. **If you have not been contacted please be patient and refrain from calling us until the following dates:**

U11 to U18 (10 to 17 year olds) September 5th

U9 to U10 (8 and 9 year olds) September 12th

U6 to U8 (5 and 7 year olds) September 19th

## SILVER/GOLD AND SELECT LEVELS

These programs are available for players who wish to play at an advanced and more competitive level of soccer. Up until, and including the age of 9 (U10 level), all teams play at the "House" or Bronze" level of play.

### U11

At the age of 10 (U11 level), if numbers and caliber permit, teams can play at a higher level of play (Red) within the club. Selection to the Red team(s) is based on tryouts and evaluations by Club coaches. All players are eligible to attend the tryouts, and all will be called prior to the tryouts.

### REP

From the ages of 11 through to 17 (U12 - U18 levels), where numbers, talent, and interest dictate, teams can play at the higher levels of play (Gold or Silver level). Selection to these Rep teams are based on tryouts and all players who indicate such interest on this form will be called prior to the tryouts.

### SELECT

At the age of 13 (U14 level), players also become eligible to play at the Select level. Select teams are comprised of the top caliber players from Delta District Clubs (Ladner, Tsawwassen, Peace Arch and North Delta). Select teams have been based in North Delta, but this may change depending on where the majority of the selected players come from.

Parents and players should be aware that participation in advanced levels of play require not only suitable skill levels but a firm commitment to the program, beginning with tryouts which take place usually over a 2 - 3 week period in May and June. If selected for a team, practices or informal workouts typically begin in August and two practices per week can be expected once the season begins. Often there can be added expense (e.g. tracksuits, bags, jackets, etc.). You are encouraged to obtain as much information as you can from the head coach or manager as to the expectations and commitments required for this program.

## VOLUNTEERS

The Ladner Soccer Club is always looking for volunteers to help us out. In addition to those amazing coaches and managers who spend so much time out in the rain with the boys, there are many and varied tasks that go unseen yet need attention. Current "job" descriptions (elected and non elected) include President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary, Registrar, Head Coach, Head Referee, Statistician, Game Scheduler, Practice Field Scheduler, Gym Scheduler, Equipment Manager, Age Group Coordinators and Photo Day Coordinator. People who are already involved as coach's hold many of these positions. There are also additional needs such as lining the fields, working the concession stand, phoning coaches, and organizing fund raising events (dances). Perhaps you have a connection with a caterer, like to go for walks while pushing a paint sprayer, or just want to get to know more people in Ladner. If any of these activities interest you, or you can think of any other way you can contribute, please indicate so on the front page of this registration form. We will be in touch as we need people.
